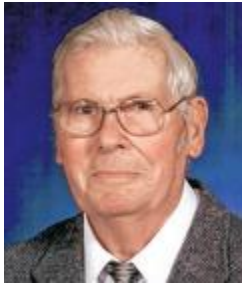


WILLIAMSVILLE - George A. Hamrick, age 79, of Williamsville, passed away on Monday, August 15, 2011 at St. John's Hospital.
